Post Surgical Instructions for Extractions

The instructions for care following surgery are as follows:

DO NOTHING to disrupt the blood clot that is forming in the extraction site for a minimum of 24 hours. This includes but is not limited to:

Rinsing
Smoking
Sucking thru a straw
Carbonated beverages
Alcoholic beverages
Heavy exercise
Brushing the surgical area
Hot, spicy, or sharp foods such as chips

CONTROL THE BLEEDING by applying pressure to the extraction site as we discussed.

You may need to change the dressing several times before the bleeding slows. It is natural to have a little bleeding but not substantial amounts. Should the bleeding continue take a regular tea bag and bite on that with pressure. This will generally stop the bleeding.
